Dear Families,

I hope that this letter finds your family well and enjoying the last bit of summer before yet another school year begins. After a year of providing virtual faith formation last year to the children of our parish, it is with great pleasure that we invite you to enroll in our in-person faith formation program for children in preschool through grade five this year! Our weekly classes provide teaching on the Catholic faith and community building through prayer and class discussions while supporting you in your promise made at Baptism to raise them as active members of the Church. We look forward to working with you this year and ask that you read through this packet carefully. We also ask that you remain flexible and patient as we receive updates constantly from the Archdiocese on how our parish program can operate during the pandemic and are utilizing some new processes. We will strive to keep open lines of communication via email, printed handouts/newsletters, and our parish website regarding any changes.

WEDNESDAY CLASSES: Classes for children ages 3 through grade five (grades six and up should register through the Youth Office) will be held on Wednesday evenings from 6:30PM-7:45PM beginning September 22nd. Our elementary program provides an overview of the Catholic faith each year building upon knowledge from previous years. Students will gather together Wednesdays at 6:30pm for prayer in the church and then will be escorted to their classrooms with their instructors for their lessons until 7:45pm. A parent or guardian will need to walk students from the parking lot to the church breezeway glass doors where they will be checked in with the Program Director or Administrative Assistant. Students will be signed in and asked a series of four COVID-19 related safety questions each week. They will then be directed to their designated class seating area in the church to wait prayerfully with their catechist until group prayer begins. After class around 7:40PM, catechists will walk their group back to the church for dismissal to the parents/guardians. All students, volunteers, and families dropping off/picking up are asked to wear a mask while on our parish campus regardless of vaccination status.

FIRST SACRAMENTS PREPARATION: If you have a child entering first grade this fall, this will be the first formal faith formation year toward celebrating First Eucharist near the end of second grade. If your child is older and has yet to celebrate the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist, please enroll as it is never too late to get started! Our sacrament preparation program is a two-year commitment with children receiving their sacraments at the end of the second year. All classes during both years of preparation are required and will need to be made up if missed. Make up classes may possibly be provided virtually. Second year Sacrament students in grades 4-6 will be required to attend Sunday classes January through April from 9:30AM-10:30AM in addition to Wednesday classes throughout the year.

SUNDAY CLASSES: Sunday classes will also be offered to children ages 3-5 who are not attending Kindergarten during the 11AM Mass. This is an alternative option for preschool families who may not be ready to attend our evening classes on Wednesdays and who would like their young children to learn more about their faith while parents are attending Mass. It is expected that children will arrive between 10:50AM-11AM for class and be picked up as soon as mass ends. No other grade levels are served in our program on Sunday with the exception of second year sacrament students in grades 4-6th on designated dates from January-April.

REGISTRATION: This year's Faith Formation class registration may be completed using the paper registration and forms included in this packet, online using a Google Form with PDF Permissions Form that can be electronically signed, or you may download a copy of the registration form from our parish website and return either printed or emailed to the Program Director. Paper registrations can be returned to the Children's Ministry Office via mail, collection basket, or drop it by the parish office Monday through Friday 8:30am-3pm prior to September 22nd. Payments can be made in person or via mail using cash or check, or using online payment through our parish online giving platform at <https://www.osvhub.com/holyfamilyauburn/funds>.

- Registrations may also be completed and dropped off during our registration events Wednesday, September 15th from 6:30:00PM for Preschool-5th grade or Sunday, September 19th from 12PM-12:30PM for Sunday preschool families in the Parish Center.

FEES: The 2020-2021 fee for Wednesday classes is \$40 per child for children in preschool through fifth grade, the same as previous years. Registration fees allow us to provide your children monthly supplies and resources for class, as well as items such as textbooks used by the catechists during the weekly classes. In January, there will be an additional fee of \$40 and an additional registration form for students receiving First Reconciliation and First Eucharist this school year. If there are any concerns regarding the fees please contact me via phone or email to discuss.

VOLUNTEERS: The success of our program relies on the help of many volunteers, and this year is no different. Please consider volunteering your time with our program. An interest form is included in this packet. All communications including registration, calendars, and the latest information about our programs is available at our parish website, www.holyfamilyauburn.org. The entire Children's Ministry team looks forward to serving your child this year spiritually. Please let me know if you have any questions or concerns, otherwise we will see you on the 22nd before 6:30PM!

Queridas familias,

Espero que esta carta encuentre a su familia bien y disfrutando del último verano antes de que comience otro año escolar. Después de un año de brindar formación virtual en la fe el año pasado a los niños de nuestra parroquia, ¡es un gran placer que los invitamos a inscribirse en nuestro programa de formación en la fe en persona para niños desde preescolar hasta el quinto grado este año! Nuestras clases semanales brindan enseñanza sobre la fe católica y la construcción de la comunidad a través de la oración y las discusiones en clase mientras lo apoyan en su promesa hecha en el bautismo de criarlos como miembros activos de la Iglesia. Esperamos trabajar con usted este año y le pedimos que lea este paquete detenidamente. También le pedimos que se mantenga flexible y paciente, ya que recibimos actualizaciones constantemente de la Arquidiócesis sobre cómo nuestro programa parroquial puede funcionar durante la pandemia y estamos utilizando algunos procesos nuevos. Nos esforzaremos por mantener abiertas las líneas de comunicación por correo electrónico, folletos / boletines impresos y nuestro sitio web parroquial con respecto a cualquier cambio.

CLASES DE MIÉRCOLES: Las clases para niños de 3 a 5 grado (los grados 6 en adelante deben registrarse a través de la Oficina de la Juventud) se llevarán a cabo los miércoles por la noche de 6:30 p.m. a 7:45 p.m. a partir del 22 de septiembre. Nuestro programa de primaria proporciona una descripción general de la fe católica cada año basándose en el conocimiento de años anteriores. Los estudiantes se reunirán los miércoles a las 6:30 pm para orar en la iglesia y luego serán acompañados a sus salones de clases con sus instructores para sus lecciones hasta las 7:45 pm. Un padre o tutor deberá acompañar a los estudiantes desde el estacionamiento hasta las puertas de vidrio del corredor de la iglesia, donde serán registrados con el Director del Programa o el Asistente Administrativo. Se registrará a los estudiantes y se les hará una serie de cuatro preguntas de seguridad relacionadas con COVID-19 cada semana. Luego serán dirigidos a su área de asientos designada para la clase en la iglesia para esperar en oración con su catequista hasta que comience la oración grupal. Después de la clase alrededor de las 7:40 PM, los catequistas acompañarán a su grupo de regreso a la iglesia para despedir a los padres / tutores. Se les pide a todos los estudiantes, voluntarios y familias que dejen / recogen que usen una máscara mientras estén en el campus de nuestra parroquia, independientemente del estado de vacunación.

PREPARACIÓN PARA LOS PRIMEROS SACRAMENTOS: Si tiene un niño que ingresará al primer grado este otoño, este será el primer año formal de formación en la fe para celebrar la Primera Eucaristía cerca del final del segundo grado. Si su hijo es mayor y aún no ha celebrado los sacramentos de la Primera Reconciliación y la Primera Eucaristía, inscríbese ya que nunca es demasiado tarde para comenzar. Nuestro programa de preparación sacramental es un compromiso de dos años con los niños que reciben sus sacramentos al final del segundo año. Todas las clases durante ambos años de preparación son obligatorias y deberán recuperarse si se pierden. Es posible que las clases de recuperación se ofrezcan de forma virtual. Los estudiantes de Sacramento de segundo año en los grados 4-6 deberán asistir a las clases de los domingos de enero a abril de 9:30 a. M. A 10:30 a. M. Además de las clases de los miércoles durante todo el año.

CLASES DOMINGOS: Las clases dominicales también se ofrecerán a niños de 3 a 5 años que no asistan al jardín de infantes durante la misa de las 11 a. los niños pequeños aprenderán más sobre su fe mientras los padres asisten a la misa. Se espera que los niños lleguen entre las 10:50 am y las 11 am para la clase y sean recogidos tan pronto como termine la misa. Ningún otro nivel de grado se ofrece en nuestro programa los domingos, con la excepción de los estudiantes de segundo año sacramental en los grados 4-6 en las fechas designadas de enero a abril.

REGISTRO: El registro de la clase de Formación en la Fe de este año se puede completar usando el registro en papel y los formularios incluidos en este paquete, en línea usando un Formulario de Google con Formulario de Permisos PDF que se puede firmar electrónicamente, o puede descargar una copia del formulario de registro de nuestra parroquia. sitio web y devuélvalo impreso o enviado por correo electrónico al Director del Programa. Las inscripciones en papel pueden devolverse a la Oficina del Ministerio de Niños por correo, canasta de recolección o dejarlas en la oficina parroquial de lunes a viernes de 8:30 a. M. A 3 p. M. Antes del 22 de septiembre. Los pagos se pueden hacer en persona o por correo usando efectivo o cheque, o usando el pago en línea a través de nuestra plataforma parroquial de donaciones en línea en <https://www.osvhub.com/holyfamilyauburn/funds>.

• Las inscripciones también se pueden completar y dejar durante nuestros eventos de inscripción el miércoles 15 de septiembre de 6:30 a 7:00 p. M. Para preescolar-5to grado o el domingo 19 de septiembre de 12 p. M. A 12:30 p. M. Para familias de preescolar dominical en el centro parroquial.

TARIFAS: La tarifa de 2020-2021 para las clases de los miércoles es de \$ 40 por niño para niños desde preescolar hasta quinto grado, igual que en años anteriores. Las tarifas de inscripción nos permiten proporcionar a sus hijos suministros y recursos mensuales para la clase, así como artículos como libros de texto utilizados por los catequistas durante las clases semanales. En enero, habrá una tarifa adicional de \$ 40 y un formulario de inscripción adicional para los estudiantes que reciban la Primera Reconciliación y la Primera Eucaristía este año escolar. Si tiene alguna inquietud con respecto a las tarifas, comuníquese conmigo por teléfono o correo electrónico para discutir.

VOLUNTARIOS: El éxito de nuestro programa depende de la ayuda de muchos voluntarios, y este año no es diferente. Considere ofrecer su tiempo como voluntario con nuestro programa. En este paquete se incluye un formulario de interés. Todas las comunicaciones, incluidas las inscripciones, los calendarios y la información más reciente sobre nuestros programas, están disponibles en el sitio web de nuestra parroquia, www.holyfamilyauburn.org. Todo el equipo del Ministerio de Niños espera poder servir espiritualmente a su hijo este año. Por favor, avíseme si tiene alguna pregunta o inquietud; de lo contrario, ¡nos veremos el día 22 antes de las 6:30 p.m.!

Holy Family Children's Ministry: Program Policies & Guidelines

The following policies will be followed by the Parish School of Religion and all its participants, volunteers, and families to maintain the safety of everyone. If you have questions or concerns regarding these policies and procedure, please contact the Children's Ministry Program Director at 253-833-5130 ext. 219. If at any time these policies change you will receive an updated copy.

1. **Wednesday Drop off/Pick up Policy:** Parents/guardians must escort children between the parish breezeway and parking lot for drop off and pick up. Students must be checked in by an adult with the Program Director or Administrative Assistant in the breezeway. Each week attendance will be taken and a series of COVID-19 questions will be asked. Students will then be directed to their assigned area of the church to wait for opening prayer with their catechist and classmates. Students will return to the church at the end of class to be dismissed to their authorized pick-up person. Everyone is asked to wear a mask before, during, and at pick up for faith formation classes. **No children may be checked in prior to 6:15pm Wednesdays as there is no adequate supervision before this time.**
 - a. **Check in Questions:** The following questions will be asked of volunteers, parents/guardians, and students prior to each class. Anyone who answers 'yes' to any of these questions should stay home or will be sent home.
 - i. Do you have any of the following symptoms within the past day that are not caused by another condition: Fever (100.4 degrees F) or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, recent loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea.
 - ii. Have you been in close contact with anyone with confirmed COVID-19 within the past 14 days?
 - iii. Have you had a positive COVID-19 test for active virus in the past 10 days, or are you awaiting results of a COVID-19 screening or surveillance testing?
 - iv. Within the past 14 days, has a public health or medical professional told you to self-monitor, self-isolate, or self-quarantine because of concerns about COVID-19 infection?
 - b. **Pick up authorization:** If an alternate person other than the child's parents will pick up at the end of class the name must be noted with the Program Director or Administrative Assistant at check in. Students will not be released to unapproved people. A list of authorized pick-up people will be kept at the check in table with the Program Director or Administrative Assistant. Concerns about which family members are authorized to pick up children must be addressed to the Program Director as soon as possible if these concerns arise mid-year.
 - c. **Early pick up:** Should any parent need to pick up a child for any reason prior to the end of class, please notify the Program Director or Administrative Assistant in advance, check in at the breezeway and your child will be escorted to you.
 - d. **Late pick up:** If you will be late picking up your child due to an emergency, please contact the Program Director at 253-833-5130 ext. 219 so that we can plan for the safe oversight of your child.
 - e. **Family Events/Parties:** Any events outside of the regularly scheduled classes in the Parish Center require parents to attend with their children. Children may not be left at events without parent/guardian supervision.
2. **Sunday Preschool Drop Off/Pick Up Policy:** Parents/guardians must escort children to the Parish Center classroom. Students must be signed in and out of class on the attendance sheets at the doors to the classroom. No children may be dropped off prior to 10:50am Sundays as there is no adequate supervision before this time.
3. **Visitor check in:** Any visitors to the campus should check in with the Administrative Assistant in the breezeway between the church and school entrances. Parents are asked to wear a mask when on the parish campus and to maintain 6-foot distance from those not in your family household. During this school year parents will not be able to sit and wait in the parish center or parish hall buildings, but may be able to spend time praying in the church while classes are being held, as long as current protocol allows for this option. Throughout the year parent faith formation options may be offered in the church while children are attending classes. Parents are asked to supervise any children that are not attending classes at all times.

4. **Weather Closure:** In the event of inclement weather, the Parish School of Religion will comply with Auburn School District closures. This information is available at <http://www.auburn.wednet.edu/auburnsd>, www.kirotv.com, the parish website, or the Parish office number 253-833-5130 ext. 219. Individual phone calls will not be made to families. Please use caution and if it is not safe for your family to travel in the inclement weather, please stay home. Should there be significant changes in the weather during the afternoon, last minute adjustments may be made to the schedule. If weather should change abruptly during class sessions, every effort will be made to contact parents while children are supervised until parents can arrive. In the event of a power outage parish phones and websites will not be in operation. Program classes will be cancelled in the event of a power outage.

5. **Volunteer Responsibilities:**

- a. **Catechist/Assistant Responsibility:** Children will be supervised at all times while attending classes by a catechist and/or assistant. In the event of online programming two Safe Environment certified adults must be present in the Zoom classroom. A minimum of two adult volunteers, must accompany class on trips where the group leaves the classroom as in a tour of the church, moving between the church, parish hall, parish center or other field trip. Children who must leave the classroom for any other reason while class is in session, will be escorted by a volunteer, such as walking to and from the restroom. Catechists will remain in the church before and after class to supervise children. Catechists will not leave church until all assigned students have been picked up by an authorized adult.
- b. **Background Checks:** All volunteers who come into contact with children are cleared at regular intervals by means of Archdiocese background checks. They also have attended the Safe Environment classes provided by the Archdiocese.
- c. **Vaccinations & Masks:** Volunteers are required to be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 and show proof of vaccination to the Program Director. All volunteers regardless of age or vaccination status will wear a mask while on the parish campus for Children's Ministry events and classes.
- d. **Safety Training:** Volunteers are trained to ensure student safety during emergency situations include fire, earthquake, and lock down procedures. Emergency evacuation maps are provided in each classroom.

6. **Code of Conduct for Child Participants (Online Programming)**

In order to assure the safe and successful participation of children and adults participating in parish online programming in the Archdiocese of Seattle, the following code of conduct is to be followed. Violation of these norms may result in dismissal/denied access for future online sessions. All participants are expected to:

- a) Follow Program Director or Adult Leader instructions at all times;
- b) Dress appropriately;
- c) All participants must login under their real name. Anybody logging in under an assumed name will be dismissed and denied further access.
- d) Refrain from behavior or using language that is inappropriate. This includes but is not limited to:
 - i. bad language;
 - ii. presentation of inappropriate images or music;
 - iii. visible use or possession of alcohol, illegal drugs, or weapons;
 - iv. disruptive actions that are tantamount to bullying, harassment, or verbal abuse.

7. **Document confidentiality:** Registration/Emergency forms are maintained by the Children's Ministry Coordinator. This information is kept confidential. Teachers are only given contact number and allergy information for their students.

Classroom Snacks: There will be no snacks eaten on site during this year's program. Please make sure your children eat before they arrive for the program so that they are able to focus on the catechist and the lesson. If at any time prepackaged snacks are provided to take home after classes, they must contain NO peanuts or peanut butter, as these can cause life-threatening reactions in some children.

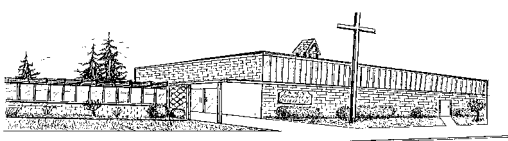

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITY/PROGRAM: _____

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is reported to be extremely contagious. The state of medical knowledge is evolving, but the virus is believed to spread from person-to-person contact and/or by contact with contaminated surfaces and objects, and even possibly in the air. People reportedly can be infected and show no symptoms and therefore spread the disease. The exact methods of spread and contraction are unknown, and there is no known treatment or cure for COVID-19. Evidence has shown that COVID-19 can cause serious and potentially life threatening illness and even death.
